Many great friendships have been forged, we learned a great deal during the process, this project has provided us a lot of joy, along the way. We have organised many successful events bringing additional motorcycling experiences to our loyal customer base. We can confidently say that we have made a noticeable difference in local motorcycle community.

We look forward to many more wonderful stories and experiences and further exploring the fascination of "motorcycles", to making new friends and providing life long memories along the way, all in keeping with our Motto "United @ The Bikes Cafe".

Achara and Martin Koller and all the team "The Bikers Cafe Thailand" in Sattahip

Achara and Martin Koller came to Thailand after Martin sold his company in Switzerland. Together they procured a guest house in Pattaya Klaang and converted it to 19 rooms, today's "Guesthouse Pattaya-City" (www.guesthouse-pattaya-city)



Both of us are very active: we participate in various sports (fitness, triathlon), have four beautiful classic cars plus two sports cars, we love riding motorcycles and in addition have five dogs and nine cats waiting for us to come home each night.

During the summer of 2018 we had the idea of founding a motorcycle group and so in the last quarter of the year we were able to officially announce the "Happy Bikers Motorcycle Friends Sattahip/Pattaya", which consisted of over ten different nationalities.





A few short months later, the estate's former sales office was put up for sale here in Sattahip. And this is where the story of "The Bikers Cafe Thailand" in Sattahip truly began!

Martin said to Achara at the time: "Let's build a little bikers cafe here for the bikers." Achara wasn't particularly enthusiastic, but that did not deter Martin at all. Planning and drawing the schematics for cafe in commenced in December having completed the removal of the old sales office from the site the previous October.







Working on an approximate 900 m2 plot, we concluded we wanted to keep as many of the trees as possible. We purposely designed the project in such a way that the trees and fauna stayed intact wherever possible. At one point during the construction phase we had to open the roof to accommodate one of the trees. The lounge had to be constructed alongside the klong river. In addition we were very pleased that we were also able to keep eight of the original 13 palm trees in the parking lot.







We initially planned to open the cafe in mid 2019, however the construction crew worked quickly, efficiently and diligently, this meant that everything was completed earlier than envisaged by the end of April 2019. All tasks were duly completed in respect of the main building with electricity, water infrastructure, soft furnishings, plus all kitchen inventory being put in place. The outside themed fixtures and water features in the garden were also finalised in the same period.

Initially we recruited six employees and we trained them in their respective duties. As a test run/soft opening, we invited all residents in this village vicinity (265 houses!) to an aperitif. Around 300 people came and really put our team





From the beginning we decided we wanted Bikers Cafe to be open from Wednesday to Sunday. We were also of the opinion that employees should receive a fair wage that enabled them to live and support their families without hardship. That's why our menu prices are slightly higher than with some of our competitors. Achara and I follow a solid work ethics ensuring that our team is paid promptly and managed fairly all as part of a family type environment.



Shortly afterwards came what no one had expected: The Corona period! We had to close both the Bikers Cafe in Sattahip and our guesthouse in Pattaya. It was clear to us that this situation was dire for many, especially so for our employees. Having discussed the potential problems with at length with Achara we decided and committed to pay the staff full wages for two years. As we can all recall they were tough times and I hope we do not see their like again.

When we initially attempted re opened we had to close for further short periods due to the ever-changing regulations such as limited seating, no alcohol sales, etc. These times were challenging Tourism and local customers were virtually non-existent at times.



When The Bikers Cafe opened in 2019 we decided to keep things simple and initially began with a small menu selection. Today we can offer our guests over 100 different Thai and Western dishes having expanded our menu exponentially.

Our workforce has now expanded to 12 employees, some of whom have been with us since the beginning.

Following the Covid period, Achara and Martin decided to offer their guests more. Not just in the culinary sector, but in the entertainment sector. It is widely accepted that until a few years ago it was almost impossible to test drive new motorcycles in the Pattaya area.

To try to alleviate this problem we began holding the "Meets @ The Bikers Cafe" working in conjunction with local manufactures/dealers of various motorcycle brands. Our aim to provide a free platform for them to exhibit their bikes whilst at the same time offering motorcycles test rides at a restaurant that has the motorcycle theme. These events have proven to be and continue to be very popular with our customers.



Depending on the weather, between 300 and 600 guests have regularly attend these events. A rich and varied buffet is available at said events comprising of 20 different dishes (Thai and Western) we believe reasonably priced at THB 259

We don't only do test rides we also organise reviews of immaculate or unusual motorcycles as part of the "Meets @ The Bikers Cafe"

program. At the last "Japanese Bike Meet" which attracted some 470 guests, there were no test rides were available due to the public holiday period however we awarded both trophies and certificates n three categories (Best Classic Bike, Best Sport Bike, Best Scooter).







For the last two years, patrons have also had the opportunity to offer their motorcycles for sale on site free of charge in our motorcycle display area. We look after these bikes whilst they are in our care ensuring they are covered at night and dusting them off when required.

We would like to offer a lot more, we are not short of ideas: motorcycle flea market, vintage car meet (cars & motorcycles), sports & super car meet, etc. Unfortunately, these topics are not as pronounced in Thailand as in the western world.

Nevertheless, we aim to achieve a lot with events outside of our restaurant: Gentleman's Ride in May, visits to factories (Ducati, BMW, Bader), Elephant Run in November, etc. We offer guests an additional program.
